

FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT *March* 5th, 2017



At that time Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil. He fasted for forty days and forty nights, and afterwards he was hungry. (Gospel)

TODAY'S GOSPEL TELLS US ... Gospel: Matthew 4:1-11

f esus spent forty days alone in the desert and was vulnerable, so the U devil tried to allure him with tantalizing temptations. Temptation is essentially an enticement to put our own desires and needs first. Resisting temptation, then, is really resisting self-centeredness. Like Jesus, we must choose instead to surrender ourselves to God who alone should be the center of our lives. To make any other choice is to choose a false god. This First Sunday of Lent poses this question: Do we serve god or God?




