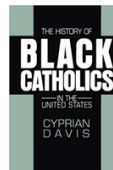

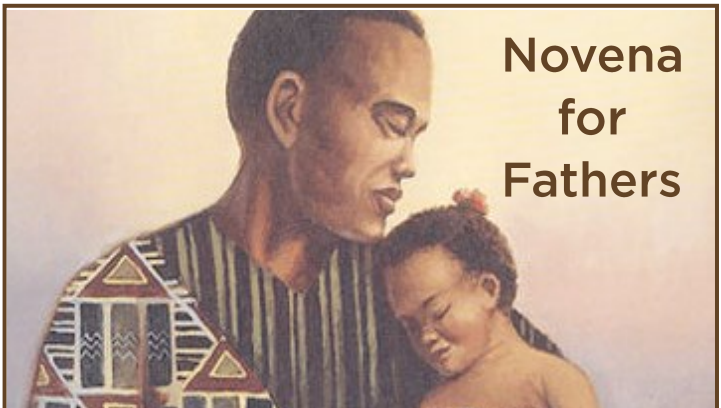
St. Anthony's of Padua Builds for Habitat for Humanity
