My name is Leah Mickens. I'm a Religious Studies Ph.D. student at Boston University My dissertation examines how the Civil Rights Movement & the Second Vatican Council affected African American Catholics in Atlanta.

As part of my research, I'll collect oral histories from parishioners of the Catholic Church in Atlanta during the 1950s through 1970s, a time period that covers the civil rights era, the convening of Vatican II, & the subsequent implementation of the Council at the parish level.
