

Reentry Awareness

Gov. Kemp declared July Reentry Awareness Month in GA. The Archdiocese of Atlanta supports this work to highlight the successes & challenges of reentry into society by formerly incarcerated individuals. To this end, the Archdiocese is collaborating in a national multifaith initiative—Ending Mass Incarceration—spearheaded in GA by Ebenezer Baptist Church & The Temple. Through naming & disrupting injustices like racial bias,



excessive sentencing laws & socioeconomic inequality we can end the damage inflicted on INCARCERATION individuals, families & communities by mass incarceration.

Reentry often comes with the ramifications of lowered employability, disruptions in relationships on both an inter-personal & communal level as well as returning to environments that may not support the goals of transformative incarceration. All of the consequences of incarceration & reentry, in addition to interwoven systemic issues like racism, mental health stigma & drug addiction, contribute to the scourge of mass incarceration.


