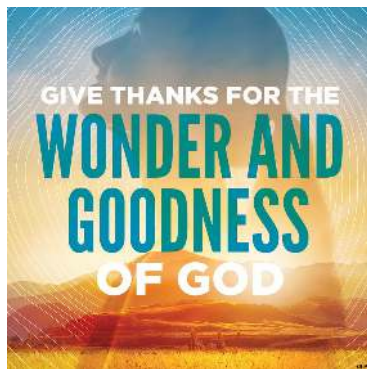

Breast Cancer Awareness Month

Breast Cancer Awareness month was initiated in 1985. The early goal of was to educate people about breast cancer & early detection tests so they could take control of their breast health. As a part of this goal there was emphasis on promoting mammograms as an important tool to be used to fight against breast cancer.



According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention a mammogram is an X-ray of the breast. For many, mammograms are the best way to find breast cancer early, when it is easier to treat & before it is big enough to feel or cause symptoms. Having regular mammograms can lower the risk of dying from breast cancer. At this time, mammograms remain the best way to find breast cancer.
