

Call for Gun Reform The bishops of the Province of the Archdiocese of Atlanta signed a statement at the Cathedral of Christ the King today calling for gun reforms to address the overwhelming wave of gun violence in America today. The Most Rev. Gregory J. Hartmayer, OFM Conv., Archbishop of Atlanta, preached about the issue at the Mass prior to the signing. You can hear his homily here.

The statement calls for several reforms including a total ban on assault rifles; universal background checks for all gun purchases; limitations on civilian access to high-capacity weapons and ammunition magazines; improved access to and increased resources for mental health care and earlier interventions; regulations and limitations on the purchasing of handguns; requirements for gun owners to provide safe storage and report lost and stolen guns. It says, in part,

"We cannot and will not stand by and silently accept that tens of thousands of people dying by gun violence each year is simply part of life in the United States. Nor can we accept excuses from political leaders that there is nothing that can be done. To do nothing is to be complicit in the violence." You can read the full statement here.

The Province of Atlanta includes the Archdiocese of Atlanta as well as the Diocese of Savannah, the Diocese of Charleston, South Carolina, and the Diocese of Raleigh in North Carolina. The Diocese of Charlotte synod is included in the province, but the bishop from Charlotte was unable to attend the province meeting. The bishops in the province meet regularly to pray and discern action on issues impacting the church and society.
