On Saturday, September 28th at 1:00pm we will have our last Safe Environment Training held here in Bowman Hall. **Only 10 seats remaining.**

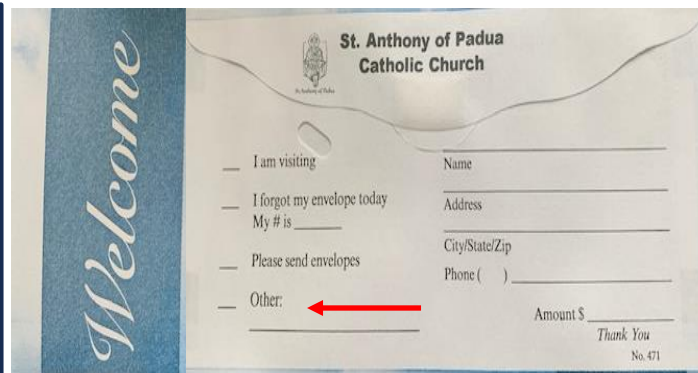
All participating ministry members, as well as new members who wish to get involved in ministry, will be required to complete the Safe Environment Training. Participating Ministries include:
